Welcome back after the school holiday break! Club Nights resume weekly again during the school term beginning Friday 12 Oct. In the meantime there are two scheduled carnivals over the holidays, with Central Cairns LC Carnival and Dolphins mini-meet in the middle weekend, and TAS over the final weekend (see below). We have two "normal" Club Nights (#3 and #4), the week after that is our Aquathon - sponsored fundraiser event on Friday 26 Oct. Times as per Club Night: you will be issued a sponsor form during the previous few weeks giving you time to get sponsors. This is intended to be a fun challenge for your kids - they will have half-an-hour to swim as many laps as they can, in distances commensurate with their ability, in their choice of stroke/s. There will be prizes to be won.

Our Club Night #4 (19 Oct.) will be the cutoff date for our first Series Awards; points earned from improvement of times will be added together and the highest ten personal best improvers will be awarded prizes (see p.5 of the Handbook for criteria).

This carnival comes at the last weekend of the school holiday. As a consequence numbers may be down a little as families may still be away taking holidays. The Friday evening stages several longer distance races, and two 50m events; there is no entry fee charged on this day. All other events make up the Saturday for which there is an entry fee of \$3.
