Welcome back after the school holiday break! We trust you all had an enjoyable two weeks...

We held our third club night on the Friday of the first week, obviously with numbers down a bit with people away, but still had an adequate turnout for a good night. The new format seems to be working, with an expanded repertoire for the juniors and integration between the young ones and the older swimmers assisting them; there are fewer main races, but we have opened up eligibility for the older ones to compete in the 25m races alongside the younger members, so there is less separation due to age. The evening ended with a fun all-inclusive race between three teams - a breaststroke chain relay.

Events for October commence with another two-day carnival held at TAS over the last weekend of the holiday - see below. Nomination will have closed for this already. We then have two club nights on the dates listed below, separated by the Central Cairns Carnival on the Saturday: this includes a 'Mini Carnival' to suit the very young swimmers for just an hour at the start.

Our Club Night #4 (25 Oct.) will be the cutoff date for our first Series Awards; points earned from improvement of times will be added together and the highest ten personal best improvers will be awarded prizes (see p.5 of the Handbook for criteria). Awards will be presented at the following Club Night.
