Short Course Carnivals

Saints SC Carnival

The first of the short course (25m) carnivals, held at the undercover Gordonvale Aquatic Centre, was a day-long meet with racing starting at 8:30am. It attracted a total of 135 athletes from 9 clubs, with 9 athletes represented by two Townsville Clubs, outside our FNQ Region. Saints Club put up the largest contingent with 33, while Stingrays had the third-largest team with 21 athletes, after Central Cairns with 27.

The meet stipulated that no awards are given, so it is more about improving one's times and given that most swimmers previous times go back almost a year ago, some dramatic improvements were made - as can be shown in the Stats at right; some best consistent improvements were made by Nathan Foote and Keely Salecich.

The Placements chart shown is purely academic, but shows the Stingrays swimmers who achieved the best ranking within their age category amongst all competitors: Emilee comes first in the Age 10 100m IM; Lachlan and Edward achieve several second, and third places in events, in their respective 8 yr, and 9 yr age groups.


