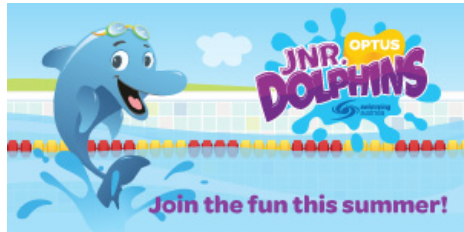

It included the Optus Junior Dolphins Carnival whereby the very young swimmers could compete in two short distances in three strokes, and a kickboard race. After another warm-up session, the main carnival began. It also featured only the shorter distances (50 & 100m), and included some novelty races using fins, kickboards, and a novelty relay.
