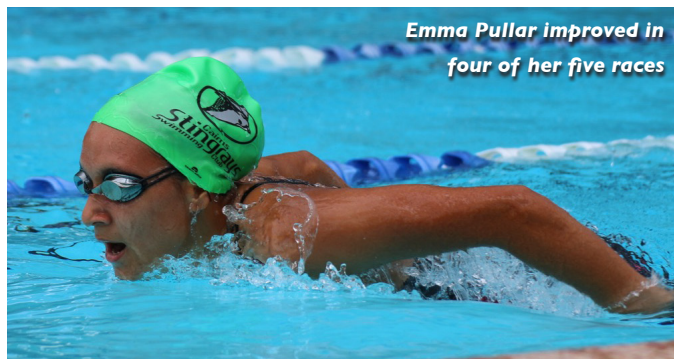

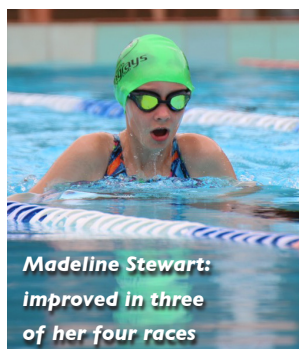

Several of our 'elite' swimmers did not attend, while we had a good representation from our younger ones at this family-friendly meet. Results are as shown in the table to right. In terms of p.b.'s, the swimmers featured on this page did well, including Emma Pullar, Madeline, Naomi, Hayden, Biem, Luis and Patrick. There was eight first-time swims, with Mark Clark and Natalie Beck doing their first 200m butterfly, Jamie and Naomi doing both 100m butterfly and 100m backstroke; Jitte did her first 100m butterfly and Toby Winter his first 200m freestyle.
